

## **CALL FOR NOMINATIONS**

### **Computational Fluid Dynamics Society of Canada Lifetime Achievement Award**

#### **Purpose of the Award:**

The Lifetime Achievement Award is to recognize individuals who have made outstanding time-enduring contributions to computational fluid dynamics in Canada. The contribution can be in the form of important advancements in the state-of-the-art of computational fluid dynamics, and/or significant impact on the use of CFD in Canada through research, teaching or innovative industrial practice. Since the intent of this award is to recognize lifetime achievements, it is anticipated that this will not be an annual award. Recipients of the award will be selected through a nomination procedure. The award will be presented at the Society's annual conference.

#### **Eligibility Criteria:**

To be eligible, a nominee for the award must have made an outstanding contribution (as outlined above) to the state-of-the-art or the practice of computational fluid dynamics in Canada. While it is not required that the nominee be a Canadian citizen, it is intended that the award be given to someone who has had a particular impact on CFD in Canada.

#### **Nomination Procedure:**

Nominations can be submitted at anytime. Nominators should include the following in their submission:

- a covering letter describing the particular contributions of the nominee;
- curriculum vitae of the nominee (including a list of publications);
- three additional letters from persons who are familiar with the nominee's achievements.

This supporting information should be emailed to the current president of the CFD Society of Canada as shown on the Society web site ([www.cfdsc.ca](http://www.cfdsc.ca)). Nominees will be considered for a period of up to three years.

#### **Selection Procedure:**

A selection committee consisting of two CFDSC board members and two experts of international stature will review the submissions and make their recommendations to the CFDSC Board for final approval.

#### **Announcement:**

Recipients of the award will be informed a few weeks prior to the Annual CFDSC conference and the official presentation will be made at the conference.
